**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations 2015**

*Made* - - - - *8th June 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *5th July 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in various locations and on various dates by reason of the intended holding of flying displays by a jet formation display team.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009<sup>(a)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 5th July 2015.

**Amendment**

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) Regulations 2015<sup>(b)</sup> are amended as follows.

(2) In the Schedule, for the entry relating to Belfast, substitute the following entry in the respective columns—

“Carrickfergus                      544243N 0054758W                      8,000 feet                      5 July”

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Schedule to the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) Regulations 2015 (S.I. 2015/1281).

The amendment omits the display at Belfast that was scheduled to take place on 5th July 2015 and replaces it with a display which will take place at Carrickfergus on that date.

Full details of the amendment will be promulgated by NOTAM.
