**The Immigration (Passenger Transit  
Visa) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2015**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999<sup>(1)</sup>, makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Passenger Transit Visa) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2015.

(2) This Order comes into force on 10th August 2015.

**Amendment to the Immigration (Passenger Transit Visa) Order 2014**

2.—(1) The Immigration (Passenger Transit Visa) Order 2014<sup>(2)</sup> is amended as follows.

(2) After article 4(q) insert—

“(qa) “(qa) a valid diplomatic passport issued by South Africa;”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Immigration (Passenger Transit Visa) Order 2014 which requires certain passengers to hold a transit visa to pass through the United Kingdom without entering whilst transiting to another country.

Article 2 of this Order exempts holders of a valid diplomatic passport issued by South Africa from the requirement to hold a transit visa.
