**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 47 Woolpit Interchange, Suffolk)  
Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015**

*Made* - - - - *12th January 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *19th January 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 47 Woolpit Interchange, Suffolk) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 19th January 2015.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 11 hours starting at 19:00 hours on Sunday 25th January 2015, or on any subsequent day until carriageway resurfacing, installation of signs and road markings on the slip roads have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any of the slip roads leading to or from the eastbound carriageway or the westbound carriageway of the A14 at the A1088 Woolpit Interchange Junction 47.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, or winter maintenance purposes.
