**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (RNAS Culdrose)
(Amendment) Regulations 2016**

Made - - - - *18th May 2016*
Coming into force - - *27th July 2016*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Culdrose, Cornwall by reason of the intended holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place there.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (RNAS Culdrose) (Amendment) Regulations 2016 and come into force on 27th July 2016.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (RNAS Culdrose) Regulations 2016(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(1) replace “510508N 0051515W” with “500508N 0051515W”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (RNAS Culdrose) Regulations 2016 (S.I. 2016/145). The amendment changes the location of the centre point of airspace restrictions for the flying displays and associated rehearsals scheduled to take place in the vicinity of RNAS Culdrose, Cornwall on 27th and 28th July 2016.

Full details of the amendment will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
