**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hylands Park)
(Amendment) Regulations 2017**

Made - - - - *2nd August 2017*

Coming into force - - *18th August 2017*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Hylands Park, Essex by reason of the intended gathering of a large number of persons at the V Festival 2017 which is scheduled to take place there.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hylands Park) (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into force on 18th August 2017.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hylands Park) Regulations 2017(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(2)(c) for “flying in accordance with the permission of Superintendant Steven Ditchburn or Chief Inspector Glen Pavelin of Essex Police” substitute “flying in accordance with the permission of the Festival Manager for the Hylands Park V Festival 2017”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hylands Park) Regulations 2017 (S.I. 2017/626) (“the principal Regulations”). The amendment changes the nominated authority who may issue permissions to operate within the restricted airspace specified in the principal Regulations.
