**The Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 103(2)(a) and (6) of the Legal Aid, Sentencing and Punishment of Offenders Act 2012(1).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention Accommodation) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2018 and come into force on 1st December 2018.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Recovery of Costs (Remand to Youth Detention Accommodation) Regulations 2013 (

[S.I. 2013/507](#)

) by inserting a new amount that designated authorities are liable to pay the Secretary of State in respect of each night on which a child is detained on remand in a secure children's home (increased from £610 to £678.70).

A full impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no, or no significant, impact on the private, voluntary or public sectors is foreseen.
