The Criminal Legal Aid (Remuneration) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2018

Made - - - - - 7th December 2018

Laid before Parliament 10th December 2018

Coming into force - - 31st December 2018

The Lord Chancellor makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(3) and 41(1) to (3) of the Legal Aid, Sentencing and Punishment of Offenders Act 2012(a).

PART 1

Preliminary

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Legal Aid (Remuneration) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2018 and come into force on 31st December 2018.

PART 2

Amendment of the Criminal Legal Aid (Remuneration) Regulations 2013

Introductory

2. The Criminal Legal Aid (Remuneration) Regulations 2013(**b**) are amended in accordance with this Part.

Amendment of regulation 2 (interpretation)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Criminal Legal Aid (Remuneration) Regulations 2013 (S.I. 2013/435; the "2013 Regulations"). In particular, the Regulations amend the legal aid fees that are

payable to advocates in criminal proceedings under the advocates' graduated fee scheme, as set out in Schedule 1 to the 2013 Regulations.

Part 2 sets out the amendments to the 2013 Regulations. Part 3 (regulation 17) contains a saving provision.
