**The M42 Motorway (Junction 9 to Junction 8, Warwickshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019**

Made 15th February 2019

Coming into force 22nd February 2019

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway (“the M42”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junction 9 to Junction 8, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019 and shall come into force on Friday 22nd February 2019.

2. In this Order –

“the motorway” means the M42 from a point 165 metres south of the centreline of Watton Lane underbridge to a point 615 metres north of the centreline of the B4114 Birmingham Road overbridge;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 25th February 2019 and ending when the said works have been completed;

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable;
- (c) being driven by, or proceeding at the direction of, a traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) being used in connection with the works; or
- (e) being used for winter maintenance purposes.
