**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Music Festivals)
(Amendment) Regulations 2019**

Made - - - - *22nd May 2019*
Coming into force - - *24th May 2019*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict the flying of unmanned aircraft by reason of the intended gathering of large numbers of persons at music festivals in the vicinity of various sites in England.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Music Festivals) (Amendment) Regulations 2019 and come into force on 24th May 2019.

Amendment

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Music Festivals) Regulations 2019^(b) are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3(1)(a) for “523231N 0011208W” substitute “543231N 0011208W”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Music Festivals) Regulations 2019 (S.I. 2019/612) (“the principal Regulations”). The amendment amends the location of the restrictions at Middlesbrough for the festival that is scheduled to take place there beginning on 24th May and ending on 26th May 2019.
