**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Auchenbreck)  
(Emergency) Regulations 2022**

*Made - - - - at 9.00 a.m. on 27th April 2022*

*Coming into force with immediate effect*

The Secretary of State for a reason affecting the public interest deems it necessary to restrict flying in the area specified in regulation 2 by reason of an emergency having arisen in that area.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Auchenbreck) (Emergency) Regulations 2022 and they come into force with immediate effect.

**Restricted airspace**

2. No aircraft is to fly below 3,000 feet above mean sea level over the area specified in Column 1 of the Schedule, being an area bounded by a circle of the radius specified in Column 2 and centred on the position specified in Column 3.

3. These Regulations do not apply to any aircraft—

(1) operating by or in the service of—

(a) Police Scotland,

(b) the Scottish Ambulance Service, or

(c) the Maritime and Coastguard Agency for the purposes of search and rescue only, or

(2) flying in accordance with a permission granted by a Police Scotland Aviation Safety and Security Officer.
