**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Sunderland)
(Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2022**

Made - - - - at 9.25 a.m. on 6th June 2022

Coming into force - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to revoke the restriction on the flying of unmanned aircraft in the vicinity of Sunderland as this is no longer needed.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and Commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Sunderland) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2022 and they come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Sunderland) (Emergency) Regulations 2022(b) are revoked.
