**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stoke on Trent)
(Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2022**

Made - - - - at 9.30 a.m. on 26th January 2022

Coming into force - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict unmanned flying in the vicinity of Stoke on Trent by reason of an emergency having arisen in that area

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stoke on Trent) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2022 and they come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stoke on Trent) (Emergency) Regulations 2022(b) are revoked.
