**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Burton in Lonsdale)  
(Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2022**

*Made* - - - - at 9.50 a.m. on 23rd June 2022

*Coming into force* - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to revoke the restriction on flying in the vicinity of Burton in Lonsdale as this is no longer needed.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

**Citation and Commencement**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Burton in Lonsdale) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2022 and they come into force with immediate effect.

**Revocation of Regulations**

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Burton in Lonsdale) (Emergency) Regulations 2022(b) are revoked.
