**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Cheltenham)
(Amendment) Regulations 2023**

Made - - - - *19th January 2023*

Coming into force - - *14th March 2023*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to amend the restriction on flying in the vicinity of the Cheltenham Festival.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Cheltenham) (Amendment) Regulations 2023 and they come into force on 14th March 2023.

Amendment of the Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Cheltenham) Regulations 2023(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(2)(c)(i) for “National Police Service” substitute “National Police Air Service”.
