Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement constituted by the Exchange of Notes of the 31st of August 1964⁽¹⁾ between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan concerning the interest free loan which has been made by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1965.

Upon instructions from Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, I now have the honour to propose that the following further allocation be made of money from the loan:—

2) Hydro-geological survey of the Madaba-Hassa area—final contribution	25,000
3) Further support for the Wadi Dhuleil investigation	20,000
4) Further contribution to the Jericho Syncline investigation	25,000
5) Final contribution to the Remote Receiver Station, Amman Airport	20,000
6) Final contribution to the Ziglab Dam to cover (a) additional cost of supervision	10,000
(b) grouting costs	20,000
7) Agricultural Census—Pilot Study	5,000
8) Wadi Yutum investigation	10,000
9) Contribution to the establishment of a Mobile Prospecting Unit	12,500
10) Agro-economic and soil survey Wadi Mujib Diversion scheme	10,000
11) Veterinary Centres—final contribution	15,494
