British Embassy,

Ankara, 3 October 1966.

Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Turkey concerning Financial Arrangements for the period ending the 1st of June 1961, relating to the Agreement of the 11th of February 1954,⁽¹⁾ which was constituted by Notes exchanged at Ankara on the 9th of December 1960,⁽²⁾ and to the Agreed Minutes of the 31st of May,⁽³⁾ and the 30th of November 1961,⁽⁴⁾ which extended the said Agreement to the 1st of December 1961, and the 1st of June 1962 respectively, and to the exchange of Notes on the 23rd of June 1962,⁽⁵⁾ on the 27th of December 1962,⁽⁶⁾ on the 17th of June 1963,⁽⁷⁾ on the 16th of January 1964⁽⁸⁾ and the 20th of August 1964⁽⁹⁾ and on the 29th of June 1965,⁽¹⁰⁾ which extended the said Agreement to the 1st of December 1962 to the 1st of June 1963, to the 1st of December 1963, to the 1st of June 1964, to the 1st of June 1965 and to the 1st of June 1966 respectively.

2. As a result of recent discussions and acting upon instructions from Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, I now have the honour to propose that the following arrangements should be put into effect:

- (a) In the period ending the 1st of June 1967, Turkish liras from the account forming the subject of the Notes exchanged at Ankara on the 29th of June 1965 will be freely accepted for purchases of Turkish fresh fruit (including citrus fruit with the exception of lemons) and vegetables and Turkish wines, or for other products which may be approved by the Turkish Government and the Government of the United Kingdom and officially notified by the Turkish Government to

Her Majesty's Embassy, intended for internal consumption in the United Kingdom and effected by traders resident in the United Kingdom up to a total amount of T.L.4,002,513·94 (four million, two thousand five hundred and thirteen, point nine four Turkish liras); this sum now being held in the Banco di Roma at Istanbul formed part of the T.L.5,000,000 (five million Turkish liras) allocated under the agreement referred to in this paragraph. The payment of this sum, and any similar transactions authorised before the 1st of June 1966 may now be completed.

(b) The Government of the United Kingdom and the Turkish Government shall discuss before the 1st of June 1967 any further arrangements required thereafter. If no agreement is reached on any further arrangements, the provisions of the Agreements mentioned in the preamble to the Notes exchanged at Ankara on the 9th of December 1960 shall once more apply.

3. I have the honour to request that Your Excellency would confirm that these arrangements are acceptable to the Turkish Government.

4. Please accept, Your Excellency, the assurance of my highest consideration.
