BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF

Your Excellency

28 March 1980.

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Singapore for Air Services between and beyond their respective territories, signed at Singapore on 12 January 1971⁽¹⁾ as amended by Exchanges of Notes of 27 May/14 June 1976⁽²⁾ and 23/30 August 1978⁽³⁾, and to recent discussions which have taken place between representatives of the two Governments concerning proposed amendments to the Schedule annexed to the Agreement.

As a result of these discussions, it was agreed that the Schedule should be further amended as follows:

- (a) the addition of "Brussels" after "Frankfurt" in column 2 of Route I of Section II and the following note shall be added to the said route "no traffic to be discharged in Brussels may be taken on board in London and no traffic to be discharged in London may be taken on board in Brussels";
- (b) the addition of "Jakarta" after "Brunei" in column 4 of Route I of Section I and the following note shall be added to the said route "no traffic to be discharged in Jakarta may be taken on board in Singapore and no traffic to be discharged in Singapore may be taken on board in Jakarta".

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Singapore, I have the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
