Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Korea for Air Services between and beyond their Respective Territories, done at Seoul on 5 March 1984¹, as amended, and to propose that:

- (i) Hong Kong shall cease to be regarded as territory of the United Kingdom for the purpose of the said Agreement, except, until 30 June 1997, for the purpose of Article 3(3) thereof, and
- (ii) British Route 2 and Korean Route 2 shall each be deleted from the Annex to the said Agreement.

If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Korea, I have the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date on which an Air Services Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Korea and the Government of Hong Kong enters into force.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
