Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Turkmenistan for the Promotion and Protection of Investments signed at Ashgabat on 9 February 1995 and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 thereof, to propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Isle of Man, and the Bailiwicks of Guernsey and Jersey.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of Turkmenistan, I have the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.
