**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A470 Trunk Road (Red House  
Bends, Cwmbach, Powys)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles,  
Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order  
2011.**

*Made* 27 May 2011

*Coming into force* 6 June 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Cardiff to Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as the “trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**1.** This Order shall come into force on 6 June 2011. Its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Red House Bends, Cwmbach, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2011.

**2.** (1) In this Order:

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20.00 hours on 6 June 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used for emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle in the length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal bicycles or tricycles in the length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order.

6. The provisions of article 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

## **SCHEDULE**

That length of the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470), known locally as Red House Bends, which extends from a point 396 metres north of Cwmbach Railway Bridge to a point 799 metres north of Cwmbach Railway Bridge, at the junction to Caerwnon Park Caravan Park, in the County of Powys.
