**The A4076 Trunk Road (Johnston,  
Pembrokeshire) (Temporary 10  
MPH Speed Limit and Prohibition  
of Overtaking) Order 2011**

*Made* 25 August 2011

*Coming into force* 5 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Haverfordwest – Milford Haven Trunk Road (A4076) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other enabling powers<sup>(2)</sup>, make this Order.

**1.** This Order comes into force on 5 September 2011. The title to this Order is The A4076 Trunk Road (Johnston, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary 10 MPH Speed Limit and Prohibition of Overtaking) Order 2011.

**2.** —1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road at Johnston in the County of Pembrokeshire which extends from a point at its junction with Langford Road to a point 667 metres north of the same junction ;

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 08:00 hours on 5 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

6. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.
