

**2011 No. 2326 (W.243)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A487 Trunk Road (Tremadog Roundabout to Porthmadog Roundabout, South of Tremadog, Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2011

*Made 19 September 2011*

*Coming into force 23 September 2011*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the A487 Fishguard to Bangor Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public;

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers (2), make this Order:

**1.** This Order comes into force on 23 September 2011. The title to this Order is The A487 Trunk Road (Tremadog Roundabout to Porthmadog Roundabout, South of Tremadog, Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2011.

**2.** —(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules to this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

**3.** Subject to the provisions of article 5 no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 5 no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

6. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

## **SCHEDULES**

### **Schedule 1 30 mph speed limit**

That length of the trunk road from a point 220 metres east of the centrepoint of the junction of the A487 with Church Street to a point 295 metres east of the centrepoint of the same junction.

### **Schedule 2 40 mph speed limit**

That length of the trunk road from a point 60 metres east of the lit traffic bollard on the south western end of the splitter island adjacent to Tremadog roundabout to a point 220 metres east of the centrepoint of the junction of the A487 with Church Street.
