**The A470 Trunk Road (Pwllan,
South of Llandinam, Powys)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions &
Prohibition) Order 2011**

Made 14 November 2011

Coming into force 28 November 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Newtown – Aberystwyth Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 28 November 2011 and its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Pwllan, South of Llandinam, Powys) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibition) Order 2011.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the trunk road at Pwllan, south of Llandinam, in the County of Powys which extends from the centre-point of the access to the property known as Neuadd Fach to a point 450 metres north of the centre-point of the access to the property known as Lower Penrhuddlan;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 28 November 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road, during such times as the restriction referred to in article 5 is in operation.

7. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, with a width of or exceeding 2.5 metres to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

9. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 6 months.
