**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A470 Trunk Road (Taffs Well  
to Nantgarw, Rhondda Cynon Taf)  
(Temporary 50 MPH Speed Limit)  
Order 2011

*Made* 12 January 2011

*Coming into force* 25 January 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 25 January 2011. The title to this Order is The A470 Trunk Road (Taffs Well to Nantgarw, Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Temporary 50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2. —1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the A470 trunk road from Taffs Well to Nantgarw in the County Borough of Rhondda Cynon Taf specified in the Schedule to this Order.

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 25 January 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour along the lengths of the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

### **SCHEDULES**

#### **Lengths of the A470, Cardiff to Llangurig Trunk Road, from Taffs Well Interchange to Nantgarw Interchange in the County Borough of Rhondda Cynon Taf.**

- i) That length of the main northbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from the centre-point of Taffs Well Interchange to the centre-point of Nantgarw Interchange.
- ii) The entire length of the northbound on slip road of the trunk road at Taffs Well Interchange.
- iii) That length of the main southbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from the centre-point of Nantgarw Interchange to a point 1850 metres south of the centre-point of Nantgarw Interchange..
- iv) The entire length of the southbound on slip road of the trunk road at Nantgarw Interchange.
- v) The entire length of the northbound off slip road at Nantgarw Interchange.
