The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 8A
Eastbound On Slip Road, Carreg
Bran, Britannia Bridge, Isle of
Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition
of Vehicles) Order 2011

Made *15 January 2011*

Coming into force *24 January 2011*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London to Holyhead Trunk Road (A55) (hereinafter referred to as the “trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and of all other enabling powers⁽²⁾, make this Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 24 January 2011. Its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 8A Eastbound On Slip Road, Carreg Bran, Britannia Bridge, Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

2. (1) In this Order:

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20.00 hours on 24 January 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle in the entire length of the eastbound on slip road of the trunk road at Junction 8A, Carreg Bran, Britannia Bridge, in the County of the Isle of Anglesey.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.
