**The A477 Trunk Road (West of
Broadmoor, Pembrokeshire)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions and
Prohibition) Order 2011**

Made 10 March 2011

Coming into force 17 March 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the St Clears – Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and of all other enabling powers⁽²⁾, make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 17 March 2011. The title to this Order is The A477 Trunk Road (West of Broadmoor, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011.

2. —1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A477 St Clears – Pembroke Dock trunk road, west of Broadmoor, in the County of Pembrokeshire, which extends from a point 288 metres south-west of the centre-point of its junction with the B4586 to a point 1655 metres south-west of the centre-point of the said junction;

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 17 March 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road.

6. The provisions of article 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
