**The A4232 Trunk Road (St Fagans
to Drope Road Over-bridge,
Cardiff) (Temporary Traffic
Restrictions & Prohibition) Order
2012**

Made 16 January 2012

Coming into force 23 January 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A4232) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 23 January 2012 and its title is The A4232 Trunk Road (St Fagans to Drope Road Over-bridge, Cardiff) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibition) Order 2012.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (*“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”*) means those lengths of the southbound carriageway of the A4232 trunk road between St Fagans and Drope Road over-bridge in the City and County of Cardiff specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 23 January 2012

and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 6 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1 50 mph Speed Limit

The length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 1600 metres north west of the centre-point of Drope Road over-bridge to a point 450 metres north west of the said over-bridge.

SCHEDULE 2 40 mph Speed Limit

The length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 450 metres north west of the centre-point of Drope Road over-bridge to a point 230 metres south east of the centre-point of the said over-bridge.

SCHEDULE 3 Prohibition of Vehicles

The length of the lay-by adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 315 metres north of the centre-point of Drope Road over-bridge to a point 105 metres north of the centre-point of the said over-bridge.
