**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A487 Trunk Road (Fishguard,  
Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic  
Restrictions and Prohibition) Order  
2012**

*Made* *6 January 2012*

*Coming into force* *16 January 2012*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Fishguard – Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited and restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**1.** This Order comes into force on 16 January 2012. The title to this Order is The A487 Trunk Road (Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2012.

**2.** —1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road in Fishguard, in the County of Pembrokeshire, which extends from a point at the existing 20 mph speed limit, at its junction with Old Newport Road in Lower Town, to a point 435 metres to the east of the eastern extent of the access to Parc Y Morfa Farm;

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 16 January 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used for the emergency services.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road, during such times as the restriction referred in article 4 is in operation.

6. The provisions of article 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition and restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
