The Protection of Freedoms Act 2012
(Commencement No.1) (Wales) Order 2012

Made - - - - 1 October 2012

The Welsh Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 120(2) and (3) of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012⁽¹⁾.

Title, application and interpretation

- 1.—(1) The title of this Order is the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012 (Commencement No.1) (Wales) Order 2012.
- (2) This Order applies in relation to Wales.
- (3) In this Order “the Act” (“*y Ddeddf*”) means the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012.

Appointed day

- 2.—(1) The provisions of the Act listed in paragraph (2) below come into force on 1 October 2012.
- (2) The provisions referred to in paragraph (1) above are—
- (a) Section 56; and
 - (b) Schedule 4.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

The Protection of Freedoms Act 2012 (“the Act”) received Royal Assent on 1 May 2012.

Article 2 of this Order commences on 1 October 2012 provisions to recover unpaid parking charges in respect of the parking of a vehicle on relevant land in Wales.

“Relevant land” is defined within Schedule 4 to the Act as land other than a highway maintainable at public expense, a parking place provided and/or controlled by a traffic authority or any other land not subject to statutory parking control.
