ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A470 Trunk Road (Llyswen, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2012

Made 18 October 2012

Coming into force 29 October 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 29 October 2012 and its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Llyswen, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2012.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the A470 trunk road at Llyswen in the County of Powys that extends from the centre-point of its junction with the A479 at Llyswen to a point 100 metres south of the centre-point of the said junction;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 29 October 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

Application

4. The provisions of article 3 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.
