(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2012

Made 9 February 2012

Coming into force 20 February 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A4232) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 20 February 2012. The title to this Order is The A4232 Trunk Road (Culverhouse Cross Interchange, Cardiff, Northbound On Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2012.

2. —1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the entire length of the northbound on slip road of the trunk road at Culverhouse Cross Interchange in the City and County of Cardiff;

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20.00 hours on 20 February 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order and the emergency services.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed along the length of the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.
