**The A487 Trunk Road (Aberarth,
Ceredigion) (Temporary Traffic
Restrictions & Prohibition) Order
2013**

Made 14 June 2013

Coming into force 24 June 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Fishguard – Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 24 June 2013 and its title is The A487 Trunk Road (Aberarth, Ceredigion) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibition) Order 2013.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the A487 trunk road at Aberarth in the County of Ceredigion specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 24 June 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions and Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 during such times as the restrictions referred to in articles 4 and 5 are in operation.

Suspensions

7. The provisions of The A487 Trunk Road (Aberarth, Ceredigion) (30 mph & 40 mph Speed Limits) Order 2003(3) are hereby suspended insofar as they apply to the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 4 and 5 are in operation.

Application

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

9. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 220 metres south of its junction with Water Street to a point 448 metres south of the said junction.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 252 metres north of its junction with Water Street to a point 512 metres north of the said junction.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 20 mph & 10 mph Speed Limits & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 220 metres south of its junction with Water Street to a point 252 metres north of the said junction.
