**The A470 Trunk Road (Dôl-  
gefeiliau to North of Ganllwyd,  
Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic  
Restrictions & Prohibition) Order  
2013**

*Made* 25 June 2013

*Coming into force* 1 July 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Fishguard – Bangor Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

1. This Order comes into force on 1 July 2013. Its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Dôl-gefeiliau to North of Ganllwyd, Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibition) Order 2013.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A470 trunk road in the County of Gwynedd that extends from a point 100 metres south of the centre-line of the access into Coed y Brenin Visitor Centre to a point 180 metres south of the centre-line of the access to the private property known as Aber-Eden;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 1 July 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### **Restrictions and Prohibition**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

### **Application**

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
