**The A465 Trunk Road (Station
Road Junction to Gilwern,
Monmouthshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Right Hand Turns)
Order 2013**

Made 18 July 2013

Coming into force 28 July 2013

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the Newport - Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A465) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 28 July 2013. Its title is The A465 Trunk Road (Station Road Junction to Gilwern, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Right Hand Turns) Order 2013.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the trunk road, in the County of Monmouthshire, specified in the Schedule to this Order;

(2) By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20.00 hours on 28 July 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle to make a right hand turn across the opposite carriageway to exit the trunk road at the locations specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.

SCHEDULE
PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND
URNS

- (i) Exit the westbound carriageway of the trunk road across the eastbound carriageway into the County Road R205 (known as Main Road), west of Gilwern.
- (ii) Exit the westbound carriageway of the trunk road across the eastbound carriageway into 'The Lion' Public House car park, west of Gilwern.
- (iii) Exit the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road across the westbound carriageway into the County Road R207 (Station Road west), west of Gilwern.
- (iv) Exit the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road across the westbound carriageway into the County Road R206 (Old Trap Road), west of Gilwern.
- (v) Exit the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road across the westbound carriageway into the County Road R206 (Station Road east), west of Gilwern.
