**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A487 Trunk Road (Great  
Darkgate Street, Aberystwyth,  
Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition  
of Waiting) Order 2013**

*Made* 6 September 2013

*Coming into force* 12 September 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Fishguard – Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (hereinafter referred to as the “trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reasons of the likelihood of danger to the public.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**1.** This Order comes into force on 12 September 2013. Its title is The A487 Trunk Road (Great Darkgate Street, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2013.

**2. (1)** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services;

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the trunk road at Great Darkgate Street, Aberystwyth in the County of Ceredigion that extends from a point 12 metres south-west of the centre-point of its junction with Baker Street to a point 24 metres south-west of the said junction.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibition**

**3.** No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to wait, load or unload at any time on the either side of the length of the trunk road.

### **Application**

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

**5.** The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
