The A40 Trunk Road (Glangwili
Roundabout to Broad Oak,
Carmarthenshire) (Temporary
Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition)
Order 2014

Made 23 January 2014

Coming into force 29 January 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Llandeilo – Carmarthen Trunk Road (A40) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (1) and of all other enabling powers (2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 29 January 2014 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Glangwili Roundabout to Broad Oak, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2014.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the A40 trunk road in the County of Carmarthenshire described in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00:01 hours on 29 January 2014 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions and Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

Suspensions

6. The provisions of The Trunk Roads (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No.1) (Wales) Order 1967(3) are hereby suspended insofar as they apply to the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 during such times as the restriction specified in article 4 is in operation.

Application

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary 40 mph speed limit

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 200 metres south-west of the centre-point of Glangwili Roundabout to a point 73 metres west of the centre-point of Abergwili Roundabout.

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 71 metres east of the centre-point of Abergwili Roundabout to a point 205 metres west of the centre-point of the B4310 Station Road Junction, Nantgaredig.

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 175 metres west of its junction with the Class 3 road to Abergorlech to a point 580 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the unclassified road to Llangathen.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 10 mph speed limit & no overtaking

That length of the trunk road which extends from a point 200 metres south-west of the centre-point of Glangwili Roundabout to a point 580 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the unclassified road to Llangathen.
