**The A4042 Trunk Road (Malpas
Relief Road, Newport) (Temporary
Traffic Restrictions) Order
2014**

Made 13 May 2014

Coming into force 14 May 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Newport – Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 14 May 2014 and its title is The A4042 Trunk Road (Malpas Relief Road, Newport) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2014.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the trunk road in the City of Newport specified in the Schedules to this Order;

(1) 1984 c.27; Section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(2) By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006, these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“restriction period” (“*cyfnod y cyfyngiadau*”) means the period commencing at 07:00 hours on 14 May 2014 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the restriction period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the restriction period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the restriction period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3.

Application

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 6 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit

That length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of the Croes-Y-Mwyalch roundabout for a distance of 600 metres in a south easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit

That length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 600 metres south of its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of the Croes-Y-Mwyalch roundabout for a distance of 230 metres in a south easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 3

Temporary 20 mph Speed Limit

That length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 830 metres south of its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of the Croes-Y-Mwyalch roundabout for a distance of 450 metres in a south easterly direction.
