**The A4076 Trunk Road (South of
Johnston, Pembrokeshire)
(Temporary Traffic Prohibitions &
Restriction) Order 2014**

Made 22 August 2014

Coming into force 1 September 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Haverfordwest – Milford Haven Trunk Road (A4076) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited or restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon or near to.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 1 September 2014 and its title is The A4076 Trunk Road (South of Johnston, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions & Restriction) Order 2014.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the length of the trunk road” (*“y darn o’r gefnffordd”*) means the lengths of the trunk road to the south of Johnston in the County of Pembrokeshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 1 September

2014 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions & Restriction

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

Application

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions and restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the A477 south of Johnston to its junction with Studolph Lane, Steynton.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 236 metres north-east of the centre-point of its junction with the A477 to a point 138 metres south-west of the centre-point of the said junction.
