**The A40 Trunk Road (St Clears
Roundabout, Carmarthenshire to
Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire)
(Temporary Speed Restrictions &
No Overtaking) Order 2015**

Made 12 October 2015

Coming into force 19 October 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 19 October 2015 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (St Clears Roundabout, Carmarthenshire to Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2015.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the trunk road between St Clears Roundabout in the County of Carmarthenshire and Haverfordwest in the County of Pembrokeshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 19 October 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions & Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

Suspensions

6. The provisions of The A40 Trunk Road (Redstone Cross, Pembrokeshire) (De-Restriction) Order 2005(3) are hereby suspended insofar as they apply to the relevant lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 3 and 4 are in operation. The provisions of The Trunk Road (A40) (Llanddewi Velfrey, Pembrokeshire) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1999(4) are hereby suspended insofar as they apply to the relevant lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules during such times as the restriction specified in article 4 is in operation.

Application

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Temporary 40 mph or 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 211 metres west of its junction with St Clears Roundabout to its western junction with the road leading to Pont-y-Fenni.

The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with Penblewin Roundabout to a point 10 metres east of its junction with Robeston Wathen Roundabout.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 258 metres west of Deeplake Bridge, east of Haverfordwest to a point 713 metres east of its junction with Scotchwell Roundabout, Haverfordwest.

SCHEDULE 2

Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with St Clears Roundabout to a point 211 metres west of the said junction.

The length of the trunk road at Llanddewi Velfrey that extends from a point 379 metres east of its junction with the unclassified road U6385 to a point 475 metres west of the Class III road C3205.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Robeston Wathen Roundabout to the western side of the said roundabout, including the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout.

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 713 metres east of its junction with Scotchwell Roundabout to its junction with Salutation Square Roundabout, Haverfordwest, including the circulatory carriageway of both roundabouts.
