

**2015 No. 294 (W. 29)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A5 and A470 Trunk Roads  
(Waterloo Bridge, Near Betws-y-Coed, Conwy) (Temporary Traffic  
Restrictions and No Overtaking)  
Order 2015

*Made* 26 January 2015

*Coming into force* 2 February 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London - Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) and Maentwrog – East of Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (“the trunk roads”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk roads should be restricted and prohibited because of works proposed on or near the roads.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 2 February 2015. The title to this Order is The A5 and A470 Trunk Roads (Waterloo Bridge, Near Betws-y-Coed, Conwy) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and No Overtaking) Order 2015.

**2.—(1)** In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk roads” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffyrdd*”) means the lengths of the A5 and A470 trunk roads at Waterloo Bridge, near Betws-y-Coed in the County Borough of Conwy, described in the Schedule to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 07:00 hours on 2 February 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### **Restrictions and Prohibition**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule, during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

### **Application**

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

## **SCHEDULE**

i) That length of the A470 trunk road which extends from its junction with the A5 trunk road in a northerly direction for 150 metres.

ii) That length of the A5 trunk road which extends from its junction with the A470 trunk road in a southerly direction for 150 metres.

iii) That length of the A5 trunk road which extends from its junction with the A470 trunk road in a westerly direction for 150 metres.
