The A494 Trunk Road
(Wales/England Border to
Queensferry Interchange,
Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition
of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians)
Order 2016

Made 2 November 2016

Coming into force 6 November 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of Dolgellau – South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that all traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 6 November 2016 and its title is The A494 Trunk Road (Wales/England Border to Queensferry Interchange, Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2016.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the westbound lengths of the A494 trunk road, slip and link roads between the Wales/England border and Queensferry Interchange in

the County of Flintshire specified in the Schedule to this Order.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on the 6 November 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

4. No person shall, during the works period, ride or cause any pedal cycle to be ridden in the lengths of the trunk road.

5. No pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

By virtue of S.I.1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1 and paragraph 30(1) of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006, these powers are now conferred upon the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

SCHEDULE

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians

1. The entire length of the A494 trunk road westbound carriageway from the Welsh/English Border to the centre-point at Queensferry Interchange.
2. The entire length of the A494 trunk road westbound link road from the A550.
3. The entire length of the A494 trunk road westbound entry slip road at Deeside Park Interchange.
4. The entire length of the A494 trunk road westbound entry slip road at Drome Corner.
