**The A4076 Trunk Road (Hamilton
Terrace, Milford Haven,
Pembrokeshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016**

Made 29 November 2016

Coming into force 3 December 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the length of the Haverfordwest – Milford Haven Trunk Road (A4076) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of the Father Christmas visit to the Winter Carnival event being held on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), as amended by The Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 3 December 2016 and its title is The A4076 Trunk Road (Hamilton Terrace, Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

- (i) any vehicle being used for police purposes;
- (ii) any vehicle being used for the purpose of fire or ambulance services;
- (iii) any vehicle being used in connection with works to the road or lighting or traffic signs or emergency works to any sewer or to any main or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or telecommunications in, or in any land adjacent to, a length of road concerned;

(iv) any vehicle used by an authorised event official in support of and for reasons of the safety of the event;

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road known as Hamilton Terrace at Milford Haven in the County of Pembrokeshire that extends from its junction with Sandhurst Road to its junction with The Rath;

“event period” (“*cyfnod y digwyddiad*”) means that period commencing at 15:00 hours on 3 December 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person shall, during the event period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be one day.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006, these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.
