**The A40 Trunk Road (East of St
Clears Roundabout,
Carmarthenshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016**

Made 13 June 2016

Coming into force 20 June 2016

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 20 June 2016 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (East of St Clears Roundabout, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the entire length of the westbound exit slip road leading to St Clears, east of St Clears Roundabout in the County of Carmarthenshire;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00:01 hours on 20 June 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs have been permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

Application

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
