**The A465 Trunk Road (Clydach,
Monmouthshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Left and Right Hand
Turns) Order 2016**

Made 11 August 2016

Coming into force 12 August 2016

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Neath – Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited from turning left or right because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers (2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 12 August 2016. Its title is The A465 Trunk Road (Clydach, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Left and Right Hand Turns) Order 2016.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the A465 trunk road at Clydach, in the County of Monmouthshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 12 August 2016 and ending when the temporary signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit any vehicle to make a right hand turn in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit any vehicle to make either a right hand or left hand turn in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

Application

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of the Order shall be 18 months.

LENGTHS OF THE A465 TRUNK ROAD AT CLYDACH, MONMOUTHSHIRE

SCHEDULE 1

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND TURNS AT MAIN ROAD

A right hand turn from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road across the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road to access Main Road.

A right hand turn from Main Road across the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road to access the westbound carriageway of the trunk road.

SCHEDULE 2

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LEFT AND RIGHT HAND TURNS AT STATION ROAD

A left hand turn from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road to access Station Road.

A left hand turn into the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from Station Road.

A right hand turn from the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road across the westbound carriageway of the trunk road to access Station Road.

A right hand turn from Station Road across the westbound carriageway of the trunk road to access the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road.
