**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A470 Trunk Road (Llanrwst,  
Conwy) (Temporary Prohibition of  
Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians)  
Order 2018**

*Made* 21 September 2018

*Coming into force* 1 October 2018

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A470 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road and of likelihood of danger to the public during potential flooding incidents.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup>, make this Order.

**Title, Commencement and Interpretation**

**1.** The title of this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (Llanrwst, Conwy) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 1 October 2018.

2. (1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Act(2) or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (*“y gefnffordd”*) means the A470 Maentwrog to East of Conwy trunk road;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 00:01 on 1 October 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibitions**

3. No person may, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

### **Application**

6. The prohibitions in article 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

B5106, for a distance of 20 metres.
