Order 2018 (Revocation) Order

Coming into force 9 September 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the M4 Motorway, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title and Commencement

1. The title of this Order is the M4 Motorway (Junction 41 (Pentyla) to Junction 42 (Earlswood), Neath Port Talbot) (Temporary 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2018 (Revocation) Order 2019 and comes into force on 9 September 2019.
