**The A458 Trunk Road (Welshpool,
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians)
Order 2019**

Made 27 March 2019

Coming into force 1 April 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A458 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 1 April 2019.

2. In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau Trunk Road;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 09:00 hours on 1 April 2019 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road specified in paragraph 1 of the Schedule to this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road specified in paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

5. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

6. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

7. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

The length of the trunk road known as Church Street, Welshpool that extends from the southern tip of the central splitter island at its junction with Mill Lane to the northern tip of the splitter island at its junction with Brook Street.

The length of the trunk road known as Church Bank, Welshpool that extends from the northern tip of the splitter island at the Brook Street/Church Street junction to the centre-point of the Red Bank/Salop Road junction.

The length of the trunk road known as Salop Road, Welshpool that extends from the centre-point of its junction with Red Bank to the eastern tip of the splitter island at its junction with Mill Lane.
