The A458 Trunk Road (Spring
Bank, Welshpool, Powys)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2021

Made 1 December 2021

Coming into force 8 December 2021

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A458 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Spring Bank, Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2021 and this Order comes into force on 8 December 2021.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services, winter maintenance service vehicles, public transport buses or vehicles being used in

connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau trunk road that extends from a point 250 metres east of the centre of the access to the property known as Spring Bank to a point 220 metres east of the centre of that access at Welshpool, Powys;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 09:00 hours on 8 December 2021 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
