**The A4232 Trunk Road (Capel
Llanilltern to Culverhouse Cross,
Cardiff) (Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles) Order 2022**

Made 17 February 2022

Coming into force 22 February 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A4232 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A4232 Trunk Road (Capel Llanilltern to Culverhouse Cross, Cardiff) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 22 February 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A4232 London to Fishguard trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 20:00 hours on 22 February 2022 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

The lengths of the A4232 northbound and southbound carriageways (including the southbound dedicated lane at Junction 33) that extend from a point 352 metres north-west of the centre-point of Culverhouse Cross Interchange to its junction with the circulatory carriageway at Capel Llanilltern Interchange (M4 Junction 33).

The lengths of the A4232 northbound entry and southbound exit slip roads at Culverhouse Cross Interchange.
