

**2023 No. 1157 (W. 200)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A487 Trunk Road (North of  
Llanrhystud, Ceredigion)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)  
Order 2023

*Made* 30 October 2023

*Coming into force* 6 November 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title and commencement**

1. The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (North of Llanrhystud, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 6 November 2023.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 6 November 2023 and ending when the temporary

traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

### **Prohibition**

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road located north of Llanrhystud, Ceredigion that extends from its junction with the U1203, Carrog, to a point 150 metres north of the access to Berth Rhys Farm.

### **Application**

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
